Whatever the connection, the Australia Indonesia Association of NSW (AIA) offers the opportunity of sharing your passion or interest in Indonesia with others.

## Background to the AIA

The AIA was founded in 1945, making it one of the oldest and longest established organizations in the world with an interest in the newly independent country of Indonesia.

It was established for the encouragement of art, culture and literature, and to foster and promote friendship, understanding and good relations between the peoples of Australia and Indonesia.

Since 1945, the AIA has been involved in a range of activities, including:

- Exchange of information, literature, films, cultural exhibitions and other cultural and educational materials;
- Hospitality to Indonesian visitors;
- Seminars and discussions with experts on Indonesian affairs;
- Participation in Indonesian celebrations in Australia;
- Annual school prize for Indonesian studies; and
- Fund raising for charities.

## What are the benefits of membership?

- Meeting like minded people with similar interests. We have regular social functions and join with other relevant organizations from time to time.
- Meeting experts and distinguished people to share ideas and information. Lectures and seminars by local and visiting guests.
- An organization to represent your interests in discussions with government and other organizations to foster greater ties between the countries and promote the study of Indonesian culture and language.
- A calendar of events with links to information on those events. Not just AIA, but many other events from other organizations which may be of interest to AIA members
- Discounted entrance fees for AIA functions.

## Membership Fee Details (incl GST)

Membership of the AIA is for individuals, not organizations or corporations.

We have three types of membership:

**Individual:** \$25 per year

**Family:** \$30 per year

Family membership includes the person joining plus his/her partner and children. Only the person joining is entitled to vote at AIA meetings. All correspondence will be sent to a single address.

**Pensioners/Full time Students:** \$15 per year

Evidence of the pensioner or student status should be submitted with the application.

In order to keep administration costs to a minimum, all communications will be via email.

If you do not have access to emails, please advise, and we will endeavour to send written communications via post.
